1. CONVENE / OPEN SESSION

1.1 Board President, Scott Smith, called the special meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

1.2 Roll call found all members present.

2. CLOSED SESSION – Continued from 9-18-12 Special Board Meeting

2.1 Student expulsion hearing – student #12-13-01.

3. RECONVENE / OPEN SESSION

3.1 President Smith called the public meeting to order at 2:22 p.m.

3.2 On motion of Mindy McCreery and second by Michele Neider, by a vote of 5-0, the Board of Trustees of the Arcohe Union School District found that the facts in the expulsion hearing for student #12-13-01 supported the charges for expulsion as established by the discipline policies of this District and the Education Code of the State of California.

- The Board found that during the previous two semesters, the student had and continues to have excessive, aggressive behavior resulting in excessive school suspensions of twenty (20) days in one school year.
- The Board further found that other means of correction are not feasible and/or have repeatedly failed to bring about proper conduct and that, due to the nature of the act, the presence of the pupil causes a continuing danger to the physical safety of the pupil or others.

Therefore, the student is expelled for the remainder of this semester plus one (1) more semester. The Board has decided to suspend the expulsion with the following stipulations:

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1. The student does not commit any violations of school policy or education code that will result in a suspension or expulsion.
2. The student is to remain in school for the remainder of this week so that special education assessments can be completed, unless stipulation #1 is violated.
3. Beginning Monday, October 8, 2012, the student is to be placed in a home-school environment supported by the Arcohe Union School District with a home teacher and/or an aide who will provide up to one (1) hour of instructional support for each school day (five [5] hours per week). This placement will continue until an I.E.P. meeting is completed to determine eligibility for special education.
 - a. If special education placement is determined, that placement will be implemented per the I.E.P.
 - b. If special education is not determined, the student will be readmitted to school with stipulation #1 in place through the end of the 2012-13 school year. A violation of stipulation #1 will immediately implement the expulsion.
4. The student shall continue to attend individual and family counseling programs, at the family's expense, for the remainder of the 2012-13 school year.
